TEST PROCEDURE

For best results, follow the directions carefully.

- 1. Use the plastic dropper supplied to collect a sample of the brake fluid.
- 2. Transfer the brake fluid sample into the plastic tube provided.
- 3. Open one "Brake Fluid Check" packet, remove the test strip (Do not touch the test pad), and immediately place into the plastic tube containing the brake fluid sample so that the aperture (indicator pad) is in contact with the brake fluid sample.
- 4. Wait one (1) minute, remove the test strip from the tube, and shake box once, briskly, to remove any excess brake fluid. Match the color of the test pad to the closest color block immediately (within 15 seconds).
